The Bureau of Special Education (BSE) is responding to the complaint filed by [REDACTED] against the [REDACTED] on behalf of the above referenced student. The complaint is dated February 18, 2015. [REDACTED] is the student's surrogate parent. In the complaint, [REDACTED] claims the district failed to fund an independent education evaluation. [REDACTED] requested a publicly funded independent education evaluation (IEE) in September of 2014. The district eventually requested a due process hearing and subsequently, in January 6, 2015, agreed to pay for the IEE. The Department of Children and Families (DCF) moved the student to a new foster home in [REDACTED] and, on February 9, 2015, issued a new form 603 *Notification to the Local Education Agency of a DCF Placement*.

It is concluded the [REDACTED] is not responsible for funding an IEE because the student's residence has changed and the district is no longer the responsible education agency. The surrogate parent should consider requesting any evaluations she thinks are required from the [REDACTED]. The complaint is closed.
