- It is not the least restricted environment.
- The presence of uniformed police officers and security are required on a daily basis.
- They are under staffed.

According to IDEA, my child has a right to be educated in the least restricted environment (LRE). As I was going through search and security at however, it made me feel as if I were entering a correctional facility - fully equipped with guards and a metal detector. The learning center at the end of the corridor was also manned by a Board of Education officer and school security. Students must be escorted to the one co-ed restroom just outside of the classroom. The students are furthermore secluded to designated areas during lunch and other electives. Unfortunately, my request for out of district placement was denied during a formal PPT. As a concerned parent and advocate I have explored my options and after visiting different schools settings I have found a "Board of Education approved private special education program" at St. Catherine Academy, located in Fairfield, CT. The facility is well staffed and has all of the tools and equipment necessary to provide with an adequate education in a least restricted environment.
